- Shelf life is 6 months when stored in a dry place.

- Gripset DM consists of cement products which may contain crystalline silica, therefore when using this product precaution must be taken to prevent long term exposure to dust.

Substrates

Substrates suitable for bonding Gripset 2P over include:

- Concrete, render and masonry
- Fibre cement sheeting, plasterboard and structural sheeting
- Wet area timber sheeting and external grade plywood
- Aerated concrete panels and blocks

Clean Up

- With soapy water while in a dry or wet state.
- Once dried product needs to be removed mechanically.

Notes
